- States hosting military facilities containing stockpiled/obsolete CW agent munitions are incorporating new agent Acute Exposure Guideline Levels (AEGLs) developed by staff of LSD/ORNL into state/local emergency preparedness programs
- June 2003—Alabama will be first host state to implement new guidelines, with CW munition destruction scheduled to begin within weeks; other host states (AR, CO, IN, KY, MD, OR, and UT) scheduled to follow suit by Sep 03
- Implementing new exposure guidance is necessary step for US compliance with international Chemical Weapons Convention (treaty)
