# **WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE PEER REVIEW PROCESS?**

To provide an equitable means for all eligible applicants to have an equal opportunity to apply for and secure federal discretionary grants.



# **WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THE PEER REVIEW PROCESS?** (continued)

Qualified peer reviewers are selected to review each application independently and then as a group, during ED facilitated panel discussions.



# HOW ARE PEER REVIEWERS SELECTED TO REVIEW FOR THIS PROGRAM?

The Demonstration Program reviewers are selected on the basis of their general and specialized experience.

\*National, local and regional experience working with college students with disabilities;

\*Knowledge of professional development or technical assistance provided by faculty to students with disabilities;
