
# **Know Your Silhouettes**



#### **Falcons:**

Long, pointed wings and long tails

Movement: strong, rapid wingstrokes

Examples: American kestrel, merlin, and

peregrine falcon

## **Accipiters:**

Short, rounded wings and long tails

Movement: 3 rapid wingbeats then glide

Examples: Sharp-shinned hawk, Cooper's

hawk, and northern goshawk

#### **Buteos:**

Long, broad wings and short, wide tails

*Movement:* soaring

Examples: Broad-winged hawk, red-tailed

hawk, and red-shouldered hawk

#### **Northern Harriers:**

Long, narrow wings and long tail

*Movement:* soaring—can appear to hover

#### **Osprey:**

Large, long wings in "M" shape and short tails

Movement: slow, steady, shallow wingboots

wingbeats

### **Bald Eagles:**

Large, dark, long wings and short tails

*Movement:* soaring with flat wings

## **Turkey Vultures:**

Large, two-toned dark coloring, long wings and short tails

Movement: teetering while soaring
