#### **DETERMINATION**

This document provides the determination from the Department of Homeland Security's Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) regarding a request for a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) for the area described above. #### **COMMUNITY INFORMATION**

#### APPLICABLE NFIP REGULATIONS/COMMUNITY OBLIGATION

We have made this determination pursuant to Section 206 of the Flood Disaster Protection Act of 1973 (P.L. 93-234) and in accordance with the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended (Title XIII of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, P.L. 90-448), 42 U.S.C. 4001-4128, and 44 CFR Part 65. Pursuant to Section 1361 of the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended, communities participating in the NFIP are required to adopt and enforce floodplain management regulations that meet or exceed NFIP criteria. These criteria, including adoption of the FIS report and FIRM, and the modifications made by this LOMR, are the minimum requirements for continued NFIP participation and do not supersede more stringent State or local requirements to which the regulations apply.

#### COMMUNITY REMINDERS

Your community must regulate all proposed floodplain development and ensure that permits required by Federal and/or State law have been obtained. State or community officials, based on knowledge of local conditions and in the interest of safety, may set higher standards for construction or may limit development in floodplain areas. If your State or community has adopted more restrictive or comprehensive floodplain management criteria, those criteria take precedence over the minimum NFIP requirements.

We will not print and distribute this LOMR to primary users, such as local insurance agents or mortgage lenders; instead, the community will serve as a repository for the new data. We encourage you to disseminate the information in this LOMR by preparing a news release for publication in your community's newspaper that describes the revision and explains how your community will provide the data and help interpret the NFIP maps. In that way, interested persons, such as property owners, insurance agents, and mortgage lenders, can benefit from the information.

#### STATUS OF THE COMMUNITY NFIP MAPS

The revised FIRM and FIS report for San Bernardino County, California, and its incorporated areas, which includes flood hazard information for your community, became effective on August 28, 2008. We will not physically revise and republish the FIRM for your community to reflect the modifications made by this LOMR at this time. When changes to the previously cited FIRM panel warrant physical revision and republication in the future, we will incorporate the modifications made by this LOMR at that time. However, the modifications made by this LOMR supersede the new countywide FIRM that became effective on August 28, 2008.

The effective Special Flood Hazard Area (SFHA), the area inundated by the base (1-percent annual chance) flood, is based on an approximate analysis and therefore designated Zone A with no Base Flood Elevations established. It has been determined that the approximate Zone A designation inaccurately represents the current flood hazards for the revision area along Sheep Creek. However, there is no detailed analysis currently available, so this LOMR will redesignate the Zone A as Zone D, which is as an undetermined, but possible, flood hazard area. Currently FEMA is conducting detailed hydrologic and hydraulic analyses along the revision area. Once these analyses are complete, a LOMR will be issued to reflect the more detailed information along Sheep Creek and this LOMR will be superseded.
