OMB Director To Testify Before Congress Today on Mid-Session Review 10:30 a.m. 210 Cannon House Building

Washington, D.C. – Office of Management and Budget Director Mitchell E. Daniels, Jr. will testify today on the Mid-Session Review before the House Budget Committee.

The Mid-Session Review includes revised estimates of the surplus, receipts, outlays and budget authority for fiscal years 2002 through 2007 and other summary information required by statute. This marks the first year that the Mid-Session Review has reported on the President's Management Agenda, included an update on its government-wide initiatives, and featured the Executive Branch Management Scorecard.

Under Section 1106 of Title 31, United States Code, the President is required to brief Congress mid-year on the state of the budget released in February. This year's Mid-Session Review was officially released on Monday July 15. A full copy of budget documents can be viewed at www.omb.gov.
