

HOW TO APPLY FOR A COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE

Study the CDL manual which can be purchased at any driver licensing or downloaded from <http://www.state.hi.us/dot/highways/hwy-v/mvso.htm>. When ready to apply for your CDL, go to any of the driver licensing stations listed at the bottom of this notice to:

- Complete an application for a CDL, DOT 4-764 (2/03), and attach a current color photograph (passport type).
- Show your driver license and proof of social security number (social security card).
- Verify your age with a birth certificate. (**Note:** You must be age 21.)
- Provide a copy of the complete medical examination report, DOT 4-766 (MVS r7/01), with certification that you meet medical and driver qualifications.
- Pass required vision and knowledge tests.
- Obtain a CDL instruction permit, which is valid for 6 months, allows holders to practice driving under supervision, and can be renewed.
- Schedule skills tests.
- Pay all necessary fees. Application fee for instruction permit or CDL - \$30; general knowledge test - \$15; other knowledge tests (passenger transport, air brakes, combination vehicles, hazardous materials, tank, doubles/triples) - \$5 each test; vehicle inspection skills test - \$10; basic control skills test - \$20; road skills test - \$20.
