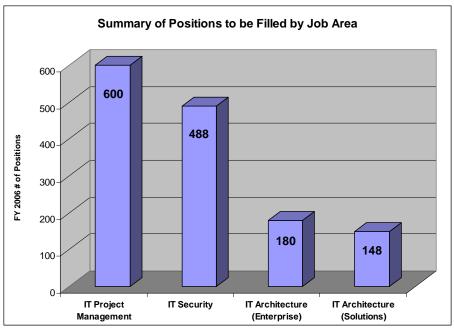
- Agency architectures are effective based on Enterprise Architecture Assessments

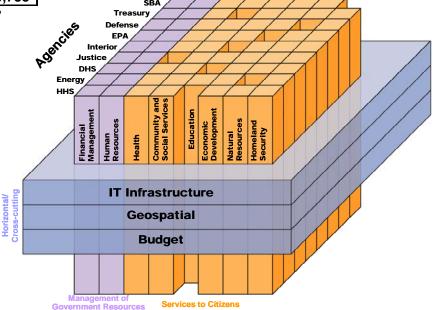

Significant potential for cost savings through consolidation and standardization.

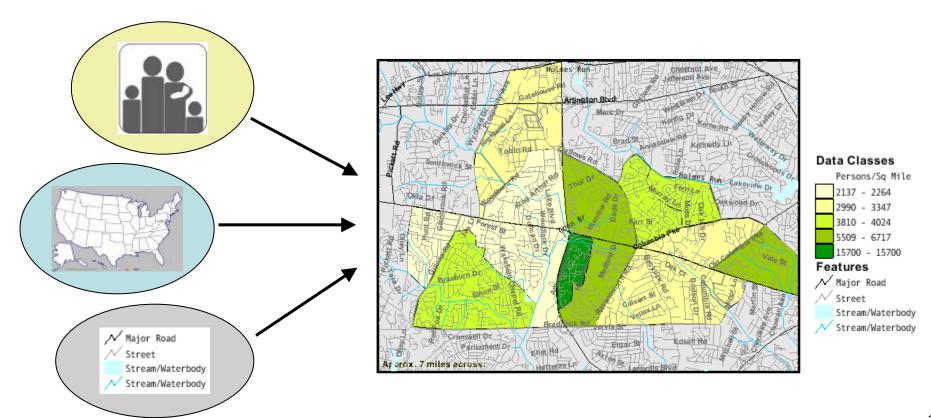






New Line of Business - Geospatial

- The taskforce will examine opportunities to share common geospatial processes and capabilities across government.

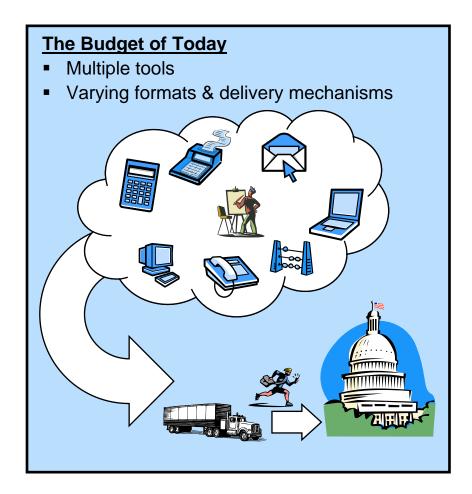


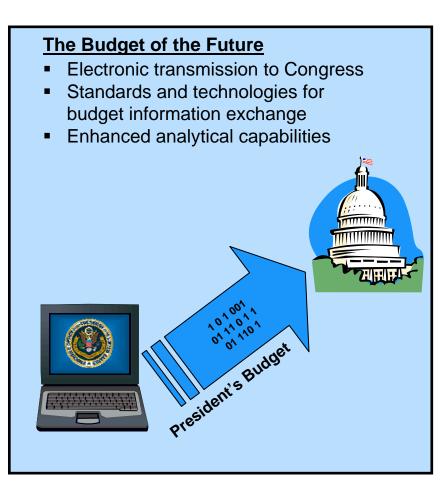




New Line of Business - Budget Formulation
