ATF OFFERS \$10,000 REWARD IN SACRAMENTO ARSON

SACRAMENTO, Calif. -- The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) has issued a \$10,000 reward for the arrest and conviction of those responsible for the March 15 fire at the Union Pacific Railroad trestle in Sacramento.

The fire destroyed a 300-foot section of elevated railroad trestle near Exposition Parkway and Tribute Road and investigators later determined the cause of the fire was arson.

ATF and investigators from the Sacramento Fire Department and Sacramento Police Department have information which they believe is valuable. However, they need additional information from the public that may assist them in solving the case.

Investigators and volunteers will be distributing leaflets to the public; the area of distribution will include numerous transient camp sites along the American Parkway.
