ATF OFFERS \$10,000 REWARD FOR WAL MART EXPLOSION Authorities Determine Explosion was Deliberate

SYLVA, N.C. – The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF) is offering a reward of up to \$10,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the deliberate explosion that occurred at the Wal Mart Superstore in Sylva, N.C., Sept. 26, 2007, that resulted in the injury of five people. A vehicle believed to have been driven by the persons of interest in this investigation is a blue or green 4 door, 1995 – 1997 Mercury Grand Marquis.

The investigation is being conducted jointly by ATF, the Sylva Police Department, the Jackson County Sheriff's Office and the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation.
