

## Helping Communities Fight Synthetic Drugs

## A 10 point plan for helping for State and local governments:

- 1. Encourage States to include in their comprehensive drug control strategies a plan to address regional meth and controlled substance prescription drug abuse threats
- 2. Identify and share the most effective State-level approaches for reducing meth production and use, as well as controlled substance prescription drug diversion
- 3. Expand Drug Endangered Children programs and training to all 50 States by the end of 2008
- 4. Increase availability of treatment and prevention programs by expanding the number of drug treatment courts and random student drug testing programs
- 5. Improve data collection related to methamphetamine use and production
- 6. Expand prescription drug monitoring programs to all 50 States by the end of 2008
- 7. Cosponsor four regional methamphetamine conferences in 2006 to coordinate Federal, State and local action against synthetic drugs
- 8. Continue ambitious training programs for law enforcement
- 9. Provide additional funds for laboratory seizure and clean up through the COPS program
- 10. Update procedures and standards for laboratory cleanup procedures
