We are very interested in distributing the MIE to our Win95 clients, and I have the license agreements here in the office. Two questions:

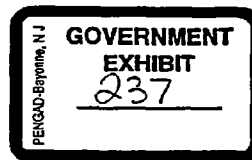
- 1 -will these agreements limit the other web browsers we recommend to our other Winx.x clients, and
