Why: CSOSA and the faith community will examine the state of faithbased offender reentry in Washington, D.C. and make plans to expand efforts.

Since the faith based initiative began in 2002 (through June of 2007) approximately 94 faith institutions have been certified as mentor centers, over 580 community members have been recruited and trained as volunteer mentors and approximately 537 offenders have been referred to the program.
