The tornado path length and width were measured as a damage survey was made on the tornado. No injuries were reported from the tornado. The tornado did cause minor damage to barns and equipment at a nearby farm. **Hartley County** 1639CST 4 S Hartley 11 0 180K Thunderstorm Wind (EG96) A rear flank downdraft or very strong downburst winds derailed fifteen train cars and approximately six power poles were snapped. The derailed trains cars blocked traffic on U.S. Highway 385. Damaging downburst winds and a couple of tornadoes occurred over the northwest Texas panhandle while large hail and high winds occurred across the central Texas panhandle.
