The lightning caused damage to the building's air conditioning system. **TEXAS, North Panhandle TXZ009** Roberts 0 0 Wildfire A wildfire twenty-six miles northwest of Miami in northwestern Roberts county burned three hundred acres. The wildfire was caused by lightning. No damage and no injuries were reported. **Hutchinson County** 2.5 W Stinnett 10 1930CST 6**K** Thunderstorm Wind (EG60) A severe thunderstorm which moved across the central Texas panhandle during the evening hours produced damaging winds which snapped off two electric poles and dropped three power lines which powered several pump jacks across State Highway 152. No injuries were reported. **Donley County** 18 N Hedley 11 1700CST 0 Hail(1.50) 0 **Collingsworth County** Quail 11 1748CST Hail(0.88) Severe thunderstorms across the southeastern Texas panhandle produced large hail during the early evening hours. No damage or injuries were reported. **Deaf Smith County** 9.5 WSW Hereford to 13.5 WSW Hereford 25 3 0 0 Tornado (F0) 28 The tornado occurred over open country and the path length and path width were estimated A severe thunderstorm produced a small rope tornado during the early evening hours in extreme southern Deaf Smith county west of Ranch Road 1057 and just north of County Road 1 which continued northwest to west of County Road MM and south of County Road 5. No damage or injuries were reported.
