Extensive flash flooding was ongoing in and around Canyon with water flowing into some homes. Five to seven inches of rain fell during the time of the flash flooding. Dumpsters and large timber were floating down the streets with water entering the Junior High School and the Intermediate School. Vehicles and other storage items were washed out of the garages at the Palo Duro Retirement Village. Many streets in Canyon were flooded and impassable...including Russell Long Boulevard...which had several cars floating down the road and was closed down. Portions of U.S. Highway 87 and the intersection of 28th Street and 4th Avenue were also impassable due to flooding. The Canyon Fire Department had to rescue about a dozen stranded motorists. The northbound and southbound lanes of Interstate 27 east of Canyon were shut down and traffic along Farm to Market Road 1541 was rerouted. Hunsley Hills Boulevard was also closed. Runoff from the rainfall washed away three hundred yards of caliche from a construction site near the intersection of U.S. Highway 87 and U.S. Highway 60. Also...a section of Farm to Market Road 3331 between U.S. Highway 60 and Interstate 27 was washed away. Water entered many homes in Canyon and several homes had water entering into the basements. No injuries and no fatalities were reported.
