

FY 2005 to FY 2006 Crosswalk - Quick Lookup Table

This crosswalk is a quick reference table. It is designed to allow a quick lookup from the FY 2005 codes (which are listed in numerical order) to the FY 2006 codes. So, while it provides a quick way to translate from FY 2005 to FY 2006, it does not show that the FY 2006 codes are actually put into logical order. Within the FY 2006 Activity Dictionary and on the ABC website, there will be another list which shows the structure of the dictionary and the codes in order as they will be for FY 2006, e.g., all Candidate Species codes begin with "A", all Restore Habitats codes begin with "W", all Administer Grants codes begin with a "7", etc.
