**BALDWIN COUNTY MAN PLEADS
GUILTY TO POSSESSION OF FIREARM**

MOBILE, Ala. - Arnold Jerome Knight of Foley, Alabama, named in a One Count Indictment charging him with possession of a sawed off shotgun, has entered a guilty plea, announced United States Attorney for the Southern District of Alabama, Deborah J. Rhodes.

On April 23, 2008, Arnold Jerome Knight, 41, entered a guilty plea before Chief District Judge Callie S. Granade to the charge of in possession of a sawed off shotgun. Knight admitted his guilt to this charge.

Sentencing is set for July 24, 2008 before Chief Judge Callie S. Granade.

This case was investigated by the United States Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms & Explosives, in close cooperation with the Foley Police Department. The case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney E. T. Rolison, Jr.
