JACKSONVILLE MAN SENTENCED ON FRAUDULENT CHECK CHARGES

Jacksonville, FL - U.S. District Judge Henry Lee Adams sentenced Aaron Tyrone Wilson, a/k/a "T-Y", age 41, to eight years' imprisonment for the crime of manufacturing counterfeit corporate checks. Because Wilson was on supervised release for a prior federal bank fraud conviction when he committed the fraudulent check violation, his supervision was revoked and he was sentenced to two years' imprisonment, imposed consecutively. Wilson was, therefore, sentenced to a total of ten years' imprisonment.

The case was investigated by the United States Secret Service and prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney and Senior Litigation Counsel Kathleen O'Malley.
