**A. BRIAN ALBRITTON BEGINS HIS TERM AS
U.S. ATTORNEY FOR THE MIDDLE DISTRICT OF FLORIDA**

Tampa, FL - A. Brian Albritton was sworn in today as the new U.S. Attorney for the Middle District of Florida. U.S. District Judge Steven D. Merryday swore in U.S. Attorney Albritton in an informal ceremony at the U.S. Courthouse in Tampa. Albritton, age 51, was formerly a partner in the Tampa office of the Holland & Knight law firm. Albritton was confirmed by the U.S. Senate on October 2, 2008. He replaces Robert E. O'Neill, who served as interim U.S. Attorney for a year.

"I am excited and at the same time humbled by the privilege of leading the U.S. Attorney's Office for the Middle District of Florida. My goal is to continue the great tradition that has made this one of the finest U.S. Attorney's Offices in the nation," stated Albritton.
