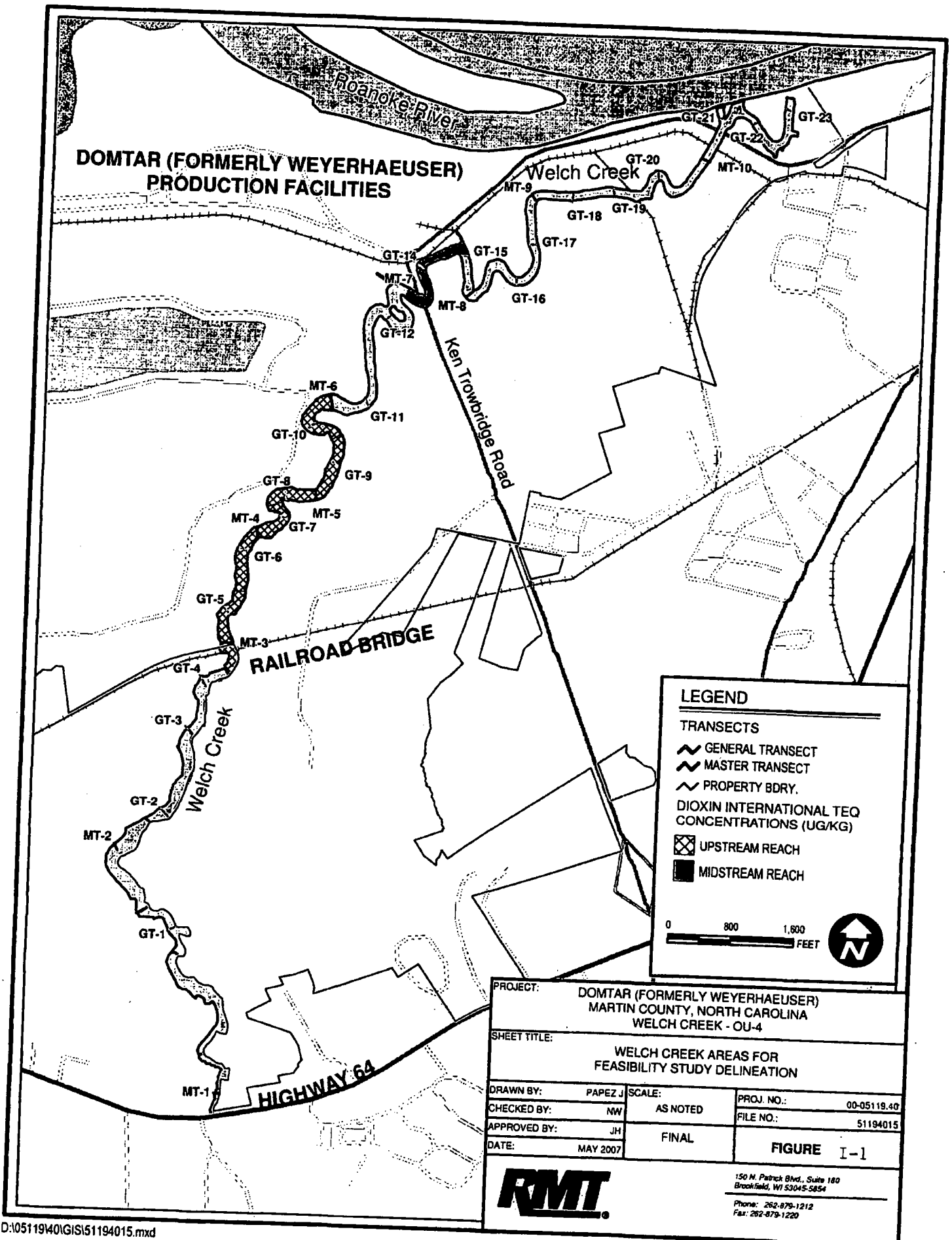

TREATING PLANT SITE, NORTH CAROLINA

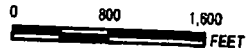
Operable Unit 4, (OU-4) will address contaminated sediments in Welch Creek. Welch Creek is a slow-moving blackwater stream located between Martin and Washington Counties in eastern North Carolina. OU-4, is a 4.5-mile portion of the lower creek extending upstream from its confluence with the Roanoke River. The area around Welch Creek is comprised of forested wetlands. The attached map shows the approximate location of Welch Creek at the facility.
