Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with section 647(b) of Division F of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, Fiscal Year (FY) 2004 (Public Law 108-199), please find enclosed the Department of Housing and Urban Development's report to Congress on its competitive sourcing efforts for FY 2005. HUD is pleased to report that four streamlined competitions were completed in FY 2005 with anticipated cost savings totaling \$4,129,780 over a period of five years. In addition, a standard competition affecting 256 full time equivalent (FTE) staff for the administration of the Office of Multifamily Housing's Non-Section 8 rental housing assistance contracts and assisted properties announced in FY 2004 will be completed in FY 2006 and included in that year's 647(b) report. The Government Accountability Office and HUD's Office of Inspector General have previously reported high risks and material weaknesses associated with HUD's rental assistance programs. It is anticipated that this competition will yield major gains in improving the performance of these rental housing assistance programs.

HUD's Competitive Sourcing Official and its Human Capital Executive Steering Committee continue to assess and identify functions for future competitions. This year, the Human Capital Executive Steering Committee is focusing on "Goal 2 – Workforce Quality" of its Strategic Human Capital Management Plan. Under this goal, HUD anticipates announcing competitions involving between 231 and 251 FTE in FY 2006.

As with past competitions, HUD will concentrate its efforts not only on achieving cost efficiency savings for the Department, but also on attaining improved program performance to meet the goals of the President's Management Agenda.
