Grand Rapids, Michigan – May 7, 2007 – United States Attorney Charles R. Gross announced that Donald Magett, age 64, of Kalamazoo, Michigan, a former Kalamazoo City police officer, was sentenced for his convictions at trial on two counts of theft of pension funds in violation of 18 U.S.C. 664, two counts of money laundering of pension funds in violation of 18 U.S.C. 1957, and one count of criminal conspiracy in violation of 18 U.S.C. § 371. Mr. Magett was the sole owner of Magic P.I. & Security, Inc., a business located in Kalamazoo, Michigan.

The defendant was sentenced to 72 months incarceration, three years of supervised release and restitution of \$539,873.06.
Mr. Gross praised the investigation done by The United States Department of Labor, Paul C. Baumann, Deputy Regional Director, Susan Fultz, Supervisor, Paul Harger Senior Investigator, and Anne Swiatek Harshbarger investigator.

This case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Michael A. MacDonald.
