I'm attaching two spreadsheets. The first is a "cross-walk" between EPA projections contained in the 1997 Climate Action Report (CAR) compared to the actual 2000 program accomplishments and the revised 2010 projections. The second is a more detailed worksheet that shows the illustrative adjustments that might be made to the AEO 2003 reference case. As noted in the documentation in the worksheet, the adjustments are based on the 1997 CAR and a useful set of runs comparing the commercial building energy requirements with and without the impacts of the Climate Change Action Plan (CCAP). The information was provided by your staff in August 2000.

I fully expect this information to be updated within the next several weeks. As you know, we have held a series of productive meetings and discussions with EIA that I hope will lead to improved estimations about program impacts.

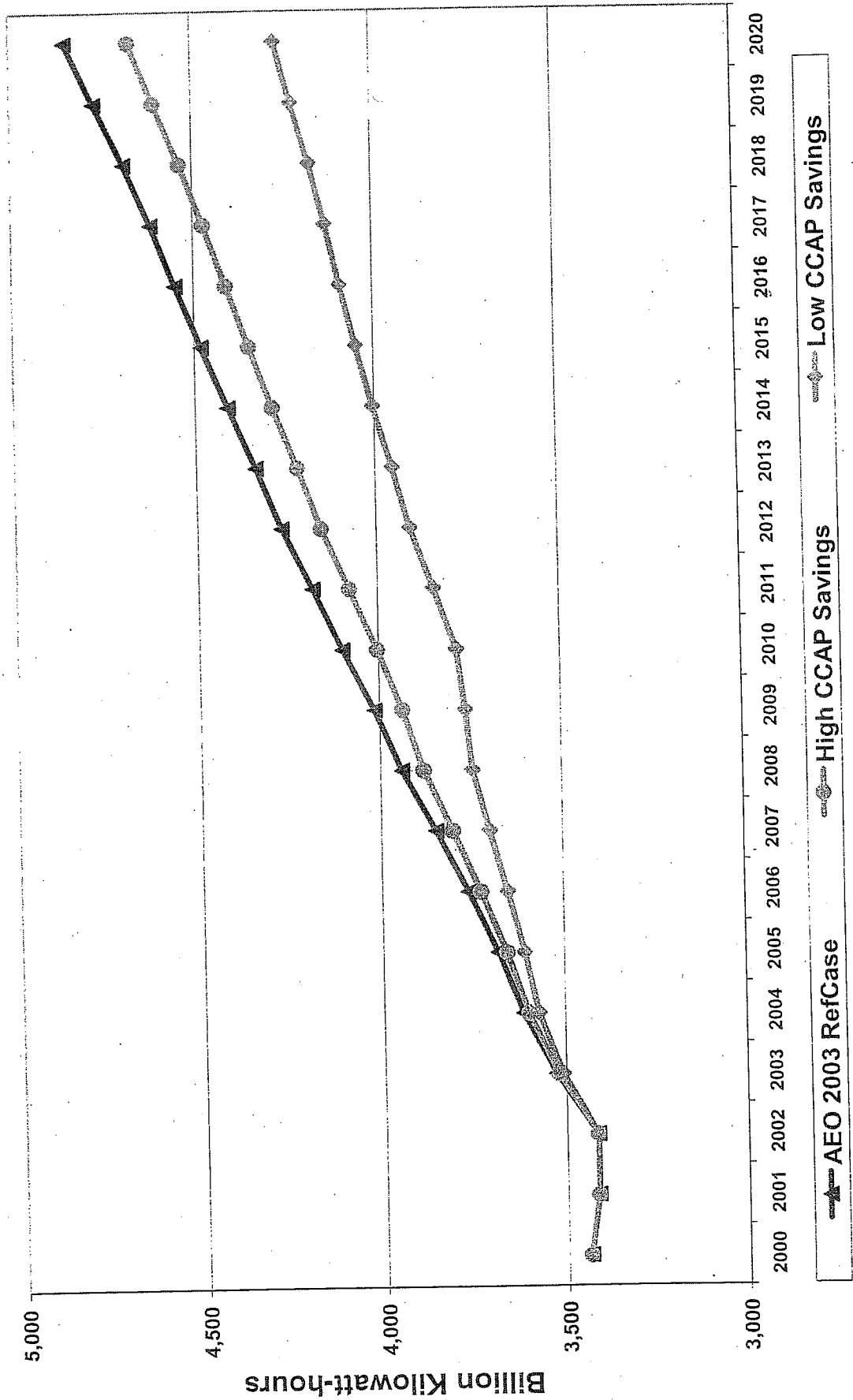

The 2nd meeting of 2005 of the Interagency Working Group on Climate Change Science and Technology (IWGCCST) will be held on May 18, 2005 from 3-5PM in the Secretary's Conference Room at the Department of Commerce. We would like DOJ to provide a presentation on current litigation issues related to climate change (e.g., CO2 emissions cases being tried in the DC Circuit). This is intended to be a status report on major cases and pending litigation issues relevant to climate change and not a briefing on litigation strategy. It would be helpful, if appropriate, to briefly describe how potential outcomes of these cases may impact the federal agencies addressing climate change issues.

As discussed on the phone this morning, I have attached the DRAFT Agenda for the May 18. I have also attached a graphic that shows the management structure of the federal climate change programs. The
