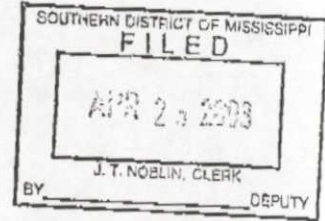



The Grand Jury charges:


That from on or about May 11, 1998, and continuing to on or about December 10, 2001, in Hinds County, in the Jackson Division of the Southern District of Mississippi and elsewhere, the defendant, **RANDY CARR**, while serving as an officer for the PAPER, ALLIED-INDUSTRIAL, CHEMICAL, & ENERGY WORKERS INTERNATIONAL UNION [PACE], Local 4-575, Jackson, Mississippi, a labor organization engaged in an industry affecting commerce within the meaning of Sections 402(i) and 402(j) of Title 29, United States Code, did embezzle, steal, and unlawfully and willfully abstract and convert to his own use or to the use of another the sum of approximately \$30,631.89, of the monies, funds, securities, property, and other assets of said labor organization, in violation of Section 501(c), Title 29, United States Code.
