
Employment Law Guide – Obtain a Free Copy Today

This free publication describes 24 major laws enforced by DOL. Written in plain language, it is geared toward employers who need introductory information to develop wage, benefit, safety and health, and nondiscrimination policies for their businesses.

The Guide's overview allows employers to quickly identify the laws that likely apply to them. For ease of use, details

about various laws are grouped by the following topics:

- Wages and Hours of Work
- Safety and Health Standards
- Health Benefits and Retirement **Standards**
- Other Workplace Standards (e.g., Family and Medical Leave, **Plant Closings and Uniformed Service Members**)
- Work Authorization for Non-U.S. Citizens
- Federal Contracts: Wages, **Hours of Work and Fringe Benefits**
- Rules Concerning the Agriculture, Mining, **Construction and Transportation Industries**



Each chapter also provides the name and telephone number of the DOL agency that administers the laws and regulations addressed in that chapter.
