- Organizing, promoting, marketing, or selling any plan or arrangement, including his trust program, that assists or advises customers to attempt to violate the (a) internal revenue laws or unlawfully evade the assessment or collection of their federal tax liabilities:
- **(b)** Engaging in conduct subject to penalty under LR.C. § 6700, i.e., by making or furnishing, in connection with the organization or sale of a plan or arrangement, a statement the defendant knows or has reason to know to be false or fraudulent as to any material matter under the federal tax laws;
- Engaging in any conduct that interferes with the administration and enforcement (c) of the internal revenue laws; and
- (d) Engaging in any activity subject to penalty under the Internal Revenue Code.
- 3. The United States is permitted to engage in post-injunction discovery to monitor the defendant's compliance with this Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction.
- 4. This Court shall retain jurisdiction of this action for the purpose of implementing and enforcing this Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction.

There being no just reason for delay, the Clerk is directed to enter this Final Judgment forthwith.
