The U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service:

- Employs 50 people in the state of Alabama.
- Manages over 60,136 acres of federal land.
- Contributes over \$5 million in payroll and operations budgets annually.
- Hosts over 1 million visitors at national wildlife refuges and fish hatcheries annually.
- Stocks more than 25,000 fish annually to support mitigation of federal water development projects.
- Federal Aid to State Fish and Wildlife Programs channeled:
 - \$4.3 million for sport fish restoration.
 - \$3.3 million for wildlife restoration and hunter education.
