- Employs 242 people in the state of Florida.
- Manages more than 775,477 acres of federal land.
- Contributes \$22.6 million in payroll and operations budgets annually.
- Hosts over 2.4 million visitors at national wildlife refuges and fish hatcheries.
- Stocks more than 1.5 million fish annually to support anadromous fish restoration in the coastal rivers of the South Atlantic and Gulf of Mexico.
- Federal Aid to State Fish and Wildlife Programs channeled:

\$8.1 million for sport fish restoration.

\$3.4 million for wildlife restoration and hunter education.
