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GYPSUM IN JULY 2007

Producers mined 2.08 million metric tons (Mt) of gypsum in July 2007 (table 1). Output was slightly more than that of June 2007 and 34% more than that of July 2006. Synthetic gypsum production was 662,000 metric tons (t) in July 2007 (table 1), which was 3% less than that of June 2007 and slightly less than that of July 2006. Both mined and synthetic gypsum are used as raw material for wallboard. The wallboard industry is the leading domestic consumer of gypsum. During January through July 2007, synthetic gypsum accounted for 4.64 million metric tons (Mt), or about 19%, of the 24.1-Mt total apparent consumption (defined as mine plus synthetic production plus imports minus exports) supply of gypsum in the United States. Sales of uncalcined gypsum in July 2007, mainly for portland cement manufacture and for agricultural uses, were 498,000 t (table 2), 3% less than those of June 2007 and 9% less than those of July 2006.

Output of calcined gypsum for July 2007 (table 1) was 1.88 Mt, 2% less than that of June 2007 and 7% less than that of July 2006. Sales of board products were about 2.57 billion square feet (239 million square meters), 2% less than those of June 2007 and 10% less than those of July 2006.

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, imports of crude gypsum in July 2007 were 844,000 t (table 3), 3% less than that of June 2007 and 17% less than that of July 2006. Canada accounted for 71% of crude gypsum imports, followed by Mexico with 18% and Spain with 10%. A small amount of crude gypsum was also imported from the Dominican Republic and the United Kingdom. Gypsum wallboard imports for July 2007 were 36,100 t, equivalent to 43.3 million square feet (4.02 million square meters). These imports were 7% less than those of June 2007 and 75% less than those of July 2006. Mexico accounted for 53% of wallboard imports, followed by Canada with 43% and China with 4%. Wallboard exports to 34 countries and territories in July 2007 were 15,000 t, equivalent to 18.0 million square feet (1.670.000 square meters). These exports were about 119% more than those of June 2007 and 83% more than those of July 2006. These large increases in the monthly export quantities are due to larger than usual exports to Ireland during July. Most of these wallboard exports went to 25 western hemisphere countries, with Mexico accounting 23% of total exports, followed by Canada with 7%.

All percentages in this report were computed based on unrounded data.
