Monthly PMO Update—September 22, 2003

Vision:

A secure business environment that facilitates and supports costeffective acquisition of goods and services in support of mission performance.

Goals:

- Create a simpler, common integrated business process for buyers and sellers that promotes competition, transparency and integrity.
- Increase data sharing to enable better business decisions in procurement, logistics, payment and performance assessment.
- Take a unified approach to obtaining modern tools to leverage investment costs for business related processes.

IAE Initial Modules and Objectives:

- Business Partner Network (BPN)— Deploy a single point of registration and validation of supplier data accessed by all agencies.
- Federal Procurement Data System— Next Generation—(FPDS-NG)-Implement a central point for consolidated collection and access of statistical and management information related to Government acquisitions.
- eMarketplace—Create an online directory of GWAC and multi-agency contracts to simplify selection and facilitate leverage of Government buying. (Phase 1)
- Intra-government Transactions (IGT)— Transform intra-governmental ordering and billing, reduce payment and collection problems, and enable swift and accurate revenue and expense elimination processes for preparing consolidated financial statements.
- Standard eTransactions— Develop a standard glossary and vocabulary to facilitate exchange of data between and within agencies.

Activities for the next month

BPN

- Issue CCR FAR change in Federal Acquisition Circular (FAC)16
- Circulate proposed novation process requirements
- Revise BPN business types to accommodate the grants community **FPDS-NG**
 - Launch system Oct. 1
 - Issue FAR guidelines for unique contract and order numbers in FAC 16

eMarketplace

- Continue comparison of shopping cart and vendor data among government catalog systems
- Continuing focus groups to determine eMarketplace functionality
- Continuing to populate ICD with interagency contracts
- Continuing gap analysis of DOD eMall and GSA Advantage processes

Standard eTransactions

- · Normalization of transactions/mapping of associated data elements
- Developing ISO 11179 naming conventions for IAE standard vocabulary
- Synthesizing XML naming standards and conventions across industry, agency, and other eGov initiatives
- Publish standard vocabulary and information exchanges

Intra-governmental Transactions

- Launch prototype IGT Portal Oct. 1 with early adopters for rent and IT services
- Begin to enhance IGTP prototype with batch file submission, multi-line accounting, and modification process
- Conduct Agency Registration Officials (ARO) User Design Day September 22, 2003 to define requirements for version 4 of Federal Registration System (FedReg)

IAE PMO

- Continue requirements analysis and SOW for IAE Portal
- Develop agency agreements for FY 04
- Issue MOUs with system managers for FY 04 O&M
- Issue governance procedures

Other Areas

- Contract Award Documents Online (CADO) Convene group to review Federal Register public comments
- Electronic Subcontracting Reporting system (eSRS) Finalize requirements for subcontracting system
- Launch Wage Determinations Online (WDOL)
