Recommendations as amended and provisionally adopted at public meeting 7/7/06:

- 1. Legislation should be enacted providing that contractors and the Government shall enjoy the same legal presumptions, regarding good faith and regularity, in discharging their duties and in exercising their rights in connection with the performance of any government procurement contract, and either party's attempt to rebut any such presumption that applies to the other party's conduct shall be subject to a uniform evidentiary standard that applies equally to both parties.

- 2. In enacting new statutory and regulatory provisions the same rules for contract interpretation, performance, and liabilities should be applied equally to contractors and the Government unless otherwise required by the United States Constitution or the public interest. [Adopted 7/7/06]
