MOLALLA RIVER CORRIDOR OPEN HOUSE
5-8 PM, October 7, 2008

SALEM--The Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Salem District, invites the public to share their ideas about recreation and stewardship opportunities on Molalla River Corridor public lands at an open house at the Molalla Public Library. The BLM manages 43,000 acres within the Molalla River watershed. This includes approximately 25 miles of multiple use non-motorized trails, the Table Rock Wilderness, and designated camping and day-use sites along the Molalla River.

The meeting will be held at the Molalla Public Library on Tuesday, October 7th. Attendees are welcome to stop in any time between 5 and 8 pm to share their ideas on three topics:

- 1) river access and recreation
- 2) community and trail connectivity
- 3) stewardship of the river and adjacent lands

The hope is that this open house will generate ideas and interest from the people who enjoy and live near the Molalla River about the type of projects that the BLM and other interested entities should explore in future planning efforts.
