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PLATINUM-GROUP METALS IN AUGUST 2008

According to Platts Metals Week, the average August prices of platinum, palladium, and rhodium dropped by 22%, 26%, and 33%, respectively, as compared with the average prices in July. The average price of ruthenium dropped slightly and that of iridium, which had held steady for 18 months, rose slightly over the same time period. Platinum, palladium, and rhodium prices plummeted from the beginning of the month until mid-month as a result of several factors including a continuing wave of investor sales, a stronger dollar, and a further decline in automobile sales in North America as well as in China and India (Johnson Matthey plc, 2008b). Following the steep decline, prices of all three metals rose slightly from mid- to late-month. In the spring, platinum and rhodium had reached record-high prices, and palladium had reached its highest price in 7 years. Since then, average monthly prices of platinum, palladium and rhodium have plunged by 38%, 54%, and 57%, respectively, as a result of the global economic deterioration.

Investors sold large amounts of platinum and palladium from exchange-traded funds (ETFs). At the end of the month, the total amounts of metals held in ETFs was 8,900 kilograms (kg) of platinum and 20,500 kg of palladium, a drop of about 34% for platinum and 2% for palladium relative to amounts held in ETFs at the end of July. The drop was attributed to the recovery of the dollar, which led investors away from precious metals (Johnson Matthey plc, 2008a).

Xstrata plc (Zug, Switzerland), submitted an unsolicited takeover bid for Lonmin plc (London, United Kingdom), the third leading platinum producer in South Africa. The bid was rejected by Lonmin (Olson, 2008).

Wesizwe Platinum Ltd. (Johannesburg, South Africa), a black-owned company, has transformed itself from a platinum explorer to a platinum producer. Wesizwe completed a feasibility study on its Frischgewaagd-Ledig project 1 year ahead of schedule. Construction on the project is expected to begin soon and production is planned to begin in 2010. The Frischgewaagd-Ledig project is expected to produce 10,900 kilograms per year of platinum by 2016 and to have a mine life of 35 years (Macharia, 2008).

Eight fuel cells have been in operation at the Montana State University in Billings since November, providing electricity to several classrooms. The fuel cells are part of a test project of the Montana Palladium Research Initiative, which is testing four platinum and four palladium fuel cells to compare their power production. Platinum has traditionally been used in fuel cells and the project is testing palladium to determine whether it can be substituted for the more costly platinum in fuel cell membranes (Pickett, 2008).
