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#### **GYPSUM IN AUGUST 2007**

Producers mined 2.06 million metric tons (Mt) of gypsum in August 2007 (table 1). Output was slightly less than that of July 2007 and 22% more than that of August 2006. Synthetic gypsum production was 775,000 metric tons (t) in August 2007 (table 1), which was 17% more than that of July 2007 and 12% more than that of August 2006. Both mined and synthetic gypsum are used as raw material for wallboard. The wallboard industry is the leading domestic consumer of gypsum. During January through August 2007, synthetic gypsum accounted for 5.41 Mt, or about 20%, of the 27.7-Mt total supply of gypsum in the United States. Sales of uncalcined gypsum in August 2007, mainly for portland cement manufacture and for agricultural uses, were 455,000 t (table 2), 9% less than those of July 2007 and 23% less than those of August 2006.

Output of calcined gypsum for August 2007 (table 1) was 1.95 Mt, 4% more than that of July 2007 and slightly less than that of August 2006. Sales of board products were about 2.78 billion square feet (257 million square meters), 8% more than those of July 2007 and 5% less than those of August 2006.

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, imports of crude gypsum in August 2007 were 761,000 t (table 3), 10% less than that of July 2007 and 26% less than that of August 2006. Canada accounted for 70% of crude gypsum imports, followed by Mexico with 30%. Gypsum wallboard imports for August 2007 were 37,600 t, equivalent to 4.19 million square meters (45.1 million square feet). These imports were 4% more than those of July 2007 and 74% less than those of August 2006. Mexico accounted for 49% of wallboard imports, followed by Canada with 43% and China with 8%. Wallboard exports to 29 countries and territories in August 2007 were 8,690 t, equivalent to 968,000 square meters (10.40 million square feet). These exports were about 42% less than those of July 2007 and 15% less than those of August 2006. Most of these wallboard exports went to 23 western hemisphere countries, with Mexico accounting 39% of total exports, followed by Canada with 11%.

All percentages in this report were computed based on unrounded data.
