GYPSUM IN DECEMBER 2007

Producers mined 1.63 million metric tons (Mt) of gypsum in December 2007 (table 1). Output was 8% less than that of November 2007 and 27% more than that of December 2006. Synthetic gypsum production was 563,000 metric tons (t) in December 2007 (table 1), which was 5% less than that of November 2007 and 7% less than that of December 2006. Both mined and synthetic gypsum are used as raw material for wallboard. The wallboard industry is the leading domestic consumer of gypsum. During January through December 2007, synthetic gypsum accounted for 7.98 Mt, or about 20%, of the 40.8-Mt total supply of gypsum in the United States. Sales of uncalcined gypsum in December 2007, mainly for portland cement manufacture and for agricultural uses, were 403,000 t (table 2), 5% less than those of November 2007 and 27% less than those of December 2006.

Output of calcined gypsum for December 2007 (table 1) was 1.45 Mt, 8% less than that of November 2007 and 7% less than that of December 2006. Sales of board products (table 2) were about 1.9 billion square feet (177 million square meters), 16% less than those of November 2007 and 17% less than those of December 2006.

According to the U.S. Census Bureau, imports of crude gypsum in December 2007 were 723,000 t (table 3), 2% less than that of November 2007 and 5% less than that of December 2006. Canada accounted for 69% of crude gypsum imports, followed by Mexico with 29%, and the Dominican Republic with 2%.

Gypsum wallboard imports for December 2007 were 16,500 t, equivalent to 1.83 million square meters (19.8 million square feet). These imports were 26% less than those of November 2007 and 58% less than those of December 2006. Mexico accounted for 63% of wallboard imports, followed by Canada with 37%. Wallboard exports to 31 countries and territories in December 2007 were 6,290 t, equivalent to 701,000 square meters (7.58 million square feet). These exports were about 29% less than those of November 2007 and 25% less than those of December 2006. Most of these wallboard exports went to 23 western hemisphere countries, with Mexico accounting for 40% of total exports, followed by Canada with 17%.

All percentages in this report were computed based on unrounded data.
