 - What is the source of the landscape or biological data?
 - What is the age of the data?
 - What is the pixel size (if applicable)?
 - How many layers are there (if applicable)?
 - What is the scale of the data?
 - What is the geographic coverage?
 - Does the data identify what is NOT there?
- The analysis of the catalogue will emphasize strengths and weaknesses and cautions for use, and will not rate tools as "good" or "bad"
- The subcommittees agreed that it would be useful to decide on an objectives statement for the Landscape/Habitat Subcommittee
- It was mentioned that landscape-level planning tools can be useful, but we should be cautioned that they may be used irresponsibly by outside parties. The subcommittee may want to consider a cautionary statement for use of the mapping tools
