SODA ASH IN OCTOBER 2007

U.S. natural soda ash production in October was 920,000 metric tons (t), 1.8% lower than the previous month's production of 937,000 t, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. Ending inventories were 203,000 t, 19.1% lower than the preceding month's inventories. Wyoming trona production in October was 1.47 million metric tons. Total production of chemical caustic soda was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

Apparent consumption of soda ash in September was 506,000 t, slightly lower than in September 2006, and ending stocks were 18.4% higher.

Exports and imports of soda ash in September 2007 were 394,000 t and 855 t, respectively.

The trends in annual cumulative soda ash statistics through September 2007, compared with those through September 2006, were as follows: production was 2.8% higher; imports were 39.6% higher; exports, 7.9% higher; and apparent consumption, slightly lower.

All percentages in this report were computed using unrounded data.
