SODA ASH IN FEBRUARY 2008

U.S. natural soda ash production in February was 878,000 metric tons (t), 5% lower than the previous month's revised production of 922,000 t, according to the U.S. Geological Survey. Final 2007 production data was 11.1 million metric tons (Mt). Ending inventories for February 2008 were 190,000 t, 14% lower than the preceding month's inventories. Wyoming trona production in February was 1.37 Mt. Total production of chemical caustic soda was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

Apparent consumption of soda ash in January 2008 was 523,000 t, 2% higher than in January 2007, and ending stocks were 15% lower.

Exports and imports of soda ash in January 2008 were 387,000 t 1,870 t, respectively.

The trends in soda ash statistics for January 2008, compared with those of January 2007, were as follows: production was 7% higher; imports were 291% higher (an unusually high quantity that may or may not indicate the beginning of an increase in imports); exports, 2% higher; and apparent consumption, 2% higher.

All percentages in this report were computed using unrounded data.

Also included in this report is Table 6 that shows reported consumption of U.S. soda ash in 2007.

Note:

The final average annual value for soda ash sales in 2007 was \$103.53 per short ton.
