SODA ASH IN APRIL 2008

U.S. natural soda ash production in April was 890,000 metric tons (t), 6.8% lower than the previous month's production of 955,000 t, according to the U.S. Geological Survey.

Ending inventories for April 2008 were 164,000 t, 15% lower than the preceding month's inventories. Wyoming trona production in April was 1.5 million metric tons. Total production of chemical caustic soda was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

Apparent consumption of soda ash in March 2008 was 524,000 t, slightly higher than in March 2007, and ending stocks were 2% lower.

Exports and imports of soda ash in March 2008 were 429,000 t and 1,200 t, respectively.

Cumulative soda ash statistics from January through March 2008, compared with those of January through March 2007, were as follows: production was slightly higher; imports were 120% higher (an unusually high increase for the quarter); exports, 6% higher; and apparent consumption, 4% lower.

All percentages in this report were computed using unrounded data.
