SODA ASH IN MAY 2008

U.S. natural soda ash production in May was 987,000 metric tons (t), 11% higher than the previous month's production of 890,000 t, according to the U.S. Geological Survey.

Ending inventories for May 2008 were 210,000 t, 28% higher than the preceding month's inventories. Wyoming trona production in May was 1.5 million metric tons. Total production of chemical caustic soda was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

Apparent consumption of soda ash in April 2008 was 491,000 t, virtually the same as in April 2007, and ending stocks were 21% lower.

Exports and imports of soda ash in April 2008 were 430,000 t and 204 t, respectively.

Cumulative soda ash statistics from January through April 2008, compared with those of January through April 2007, were as follows: production was slightly higher; imports were 90% higher (an unusually high increase for the 4 month period); exports, 5% higher; and apparent consumption, 3% lower.

All percentages in this report were computed using unrounded data.
