## SODA ASH IN AUGUST 2008

U.S. natural soda ash production in August was 976,000 metric tons ( t ), $8 \%$ higher than the previous month's production of $905,000 \mathrm{t}$, according to the U.S. Geological Survey.

Ending inventories for August 2008 were 222,000 t, 34\% higher than the preceding month's inventories. Wyoming trona production in August was 1.5 million metric tons. Total production of chemical caustic soda was withheld to avoid disclosing company proprietary data.

Apparent consumption of soda ash in July 2008 was $534,000 \mathrm{t}, 17 \%$ higher than in July 2007, and ending stocks were $20 \%$ lower.

Exports and imports of soda ash in July 2008 were 417,000 t and 632 t , respectively.

Cumulative soda ash statistics from January through July 2008, compared with those of January through July 2007, were as follows: production was slightly higher; imports were 52\% higher; exports were 3\% higher; and apparent consumption, $3 \%$ lower. Although imports have risen dramatically in 2008 compared with those of 2007, they still represent less than 1\% of apparent consumption.

All percentages in this report were computed using unrounded data.
