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CEMENT IN OCTOBER AND NOVEMBER 2007

This report provides monthly data on the shipments of cement to final customers, and the production of clinker, in the United States from January 2006 through November 2007.¹ Data on the imports of cement and clinker are also provided; a separate set of trade tables (tables 5–7) for October has been included because a separate October report was not released.

Total shipments of portland and blended cement in the United States and Puerto Rico for October 2007 were about 10.9 million metric tons (Mt). This was 3.9% lower than shipments in October 2006 (tables 2A and 2B). Shipments year-to-date for October totaled about 97.0 Mt, down by 9.0% compared with those (revised) of the same period in 2006. Total shipments of portland and blended cement in the United States and Puerto Rico for November 2007 were about 9.4 million metric tons (Mt), about 4.9% lower than shipments in November 2006. Shipments through November totaled about 106.3 Mt, down by 8.7% compared with those (revised) of the same period in 2006.

Clinker production in October totaled about 7.5 Mt, about 4.8% lower than the production in October 2006 (table 4). Production year-to-date for October was 72.6 Mt, down by 3.0%

from that of the same period in 2006. Clinker production in November was about 7.3 Mt, down 2.8% from that in November 2006. Production year-to-date for November was 79.9 Mt, down almost 3.0% from the same period in 2006.

Masonry cement shipments in October of about 369,000 metric tons were 19.8% lower than shipments for October 2006 (table 2C). Shipments year-to-date for October were 3.76 Mt, down by 19.6% from those of the same period in 2006. In November, masonry shipments totaled about 306,000 metric tons, down by 22.3% from those in November 2006. Year-to-date shipments for November totaled 4.06 Mt, down by 19.8%.

Tables 5, 5a, 6, 6a, 7, and 7a contain import data from the U.S. Census Bureau for October and November 2007. October 2007 imports of cement and clinker were about 1.9 Mt, down by about 29% from imports in October 2006, and imports year-to-date were about 19.9 Mt, down by about 37% from those of the same period in 2006. In November, imports totaled 1.4 Mt, down by 44% from those in November 2006; and imports year-to-date totaled 21.3 Mt, down by 37%.
