DILLON BLM CONSIDERS RECREATION PERMIT PROPOSALS

DILLON (April 24, 2006) – The Bureau of Land Management, Dillon Field Office is seeking public comment on two applications for Special Recreation Permit to use public lands in the Ennis area. To be considered in the environmental assessment, comments need to be submitted by May 10.

Proposals include the use of public land for overnight float fishing trips along the upper Madison River between Quake Lake and Ennis Lake and day-use horseback trips on the southeast slopes of the Tobacco Root Mountains.
