GLASGOW – A 40-acre parcel of public land on the northwest outskirts of Glasgow will be auctioned Sept. 14 at 1 p.m. at the Bureau of Land Management’s Glasgow office.

The land is along U.S. Highway 2 about a mile from the city limits and is also accessed by a well-maintained county road. The Jensen Trail bisects the property. The legal description of the property is T. 29 N., R. 39 E., sec 33 SW¼ E¼.

Sealed bids will be accepted until the close of business on Sept. 13. The minimum bid is \$26,000, the appraised market value of the parcel. The next day, those wishing to make oral bids may do so at the BLM’s Glasgow Field Station. Oral bidding will begin at the highest offer received through sealed bids.

Sealed bids must be clearly marked on front, lower left-hand corner with “BLM Land Sale MT, MTM-93474.” Bids should be sent to BLM Glasgow Field Station, P.O. Box 871, 605 2nd Ave. S. Room 206, Glasgow, Mont. 59230. Bids must include payment of at least 10 percent of the amount bid. There are other requirements in order to submit a qualifying bid.
