Glasgow, MT----The Bureau of Land Management's Central Montana Resource Advisory Council (RAC) will meet July 12 & 13 at the Cottonwood Inn in Glasgow, Montana.

The July 12 session will consist of a field trip for RAC members to various public land projects in the Glasgow area.

The formal July 13 business meeting will begin at 8:00 a.m. with a 30-minute public comment period. The RAC will then discuss the American Prairie Foundation project, the Malta Resource Management Plan, the Bowdoin Gas Field and transportation planning. This meeting is scheduled to adjourn by 3:00 p.m.

The Central Montana RAC is a 15-member citizen advisory group that advises the Secretary of the Interior, through the BLM, on a wide variety of public land and resource issues.

All formal RAC meetings are open to the public.
