PRESCRIBED BURNS PLANNED NORTH OF POTOMAC

MISSOULA, (April 24, 2006) – The Missoula Field Office of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) is preparing for prescribed burns in the Elk Creek and Keno Creek drainages about ten miles southeast of Greenough. The burn will take up to five days to complete and will take place when weather and fuel conditions are favorable, but could occur anytime during the next month.

The prescribed burns will reduce the amount of fuel in the area by removing hazardous fuels. By removing the small, "ladder fuels" and down woody debris, the risk of large, catastrophic wildfires is also reduced. Fuels specialists are attempting to restore the historic conditions characterized by large diameter western larch and Douglas fir with intermittent openings.
