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# Introduce Your Service Opportunity through -

- the 2-line program description
- the program description
- the Member duties description

# 2-Line Program Description

- First introduction to your program; Sell your locale.
- Equivalent to a Headline, sound bite or 30-second commercial
- Use a “Challenge Question” – *“Did know that among homeless women, 60 percent have children under age 18?”*
- Use catchy phrases - “an award winning challenge”; “make a difference”; “serve your community”
- Use terms such as leader(ship), create, challenge, experience, design, improve



# Program Description

- What is the mission of your organization?
- Who is the audience served?
- Highlight activities about your program.
- Select service areas.

# Member Duties

- What will your members do?
  - Give examples
  - Use everyday language
- Skills that they may acquire while serving.
  - What would look good on their resume.

- Child care assistance, if eligible
- Health Coverage

- Living Allowance

# Words to Avoid

- Employment
- Job
- Hire
- Salary
- Work
- Organization specific jargon
- Acronyms
- Ambiguous terms
