

Plans for New PPI Service Sector Aggregation Indexes

Plans for New PPI Service Sector Aggregation Indexes

During the fall 2005 FESAC presentation on the Future of the PPI, it was noted that current systems limited the PPI program's abilities to incorporate services data into broad economic aggregation structures. Since that meeting, and in response to concerns expressed that the timing of systems development will mean that such aggregation measures will not be published until at least 2010, the PPI staff conducted a study to analyze current data and systems capabilities to determine if there are any meaningful service aggregate indexes that could be calculated using the current system.

The PPI currently calculates and publishes index values net output indexes for many NAICS sub-sectors, industry groups and 5-digit NAICS industries in addition to the publication of 6-digit national industries. In a net output aggregate index, the component industry indexes are assigned weights that exclude all shipments to other industries within that aggregation. This weighting methodology eliminates the problem of multiple counting of price changes within that aggregation. Aggregate indexes are calculated and published for the mining and manufacturing sectors; however, the PPI does not currently calculate or publish aggregate net output indexes for any other sectors. The PPI program does calculate and publish sub-sector and industry group indexes for any of aggregates for which there is adequate coverage.

Planning is underway to begin calculating and publishing sector indexes in each sector where we have adequate coverage. In addition, the PPI does not currently calculate any aggregate indexes that cross sectors. The PPI does publish a table that displays some service industry net output index in special groupings; however, an aggregate net output index is not calculated for the group as a whole. In order to expand data availability, we plan to begin calculating and publishing indexes for these aggregations in January 2007. We have also identified a few additional aggregations that we feel might help to meet user needs. Most of the new indexes are in the services; however, this analysis also identified an additional mining and manufacturing related index that could be calculated. The new net output aggregate indexes that the PPI program is proposing to calculate and publish are listed below followed by a draft of the table that will include these indexes. As we work out the details over the next few months, this proposal may be altered slightly.

Total Mining, Utilities and Manufacturing – This index is a cross sector aggregate index that represents the net output of the Mining, Utilities and Manufacturing sectors.

Wholesale Trade and Retail Trade – These are two new aggregate net output indexes that represent the net output for the wholesale trade sector and the retail trade sector.

Total Trades -- In addition, this is another new cross sector aggregate index that represents the net output of the combined wholesale and retail trade sectors.

Transportation – This index is a sub-sector, net output aggregate index that represents the output of all the transportation industries. These industries are found in NAICS 48.

Delivery and Warehouse industries – This index is a sub-sector, net output aggregate index that represents the combination of delivery service industries and the warehousing and storage industries. The delivery service industries include the US postal service, courier services and local messengers services.

Transportation and Warehousing -- This index is a sector, net output aggregate index that represents all the NAICS 48 and 49 industries. This sector also includes Postal Service and Courier Services.

Selected Health Care – This index is a net output aggregate index for all the health care services that are currently priced in the PPI. This index represents the net output of the NAICS 621, 622 and 623 sub-sectors.

Information – This is a sector, net output aggregate index that represents the net output of the information sector. This index includes industry data from NAICS sub-sectors 511, 515, 517 and 518.

Other Selected Traditional Services– This is a cross sector, net output aggregate index that represents the various service industries that are priced in the PPI but not included in other sector aggregations. The sectors and industries which are included in this index are:

- Finance
- Insurance
- Administrative and support
- Professional services
- Real estate and rental and leasing
- Amusement and recreation
- Accommodation

Total Tradition Services – This is a cross sector, net output aggregate index that represents the net output of all the services currently priced in the PPI. These services included in this aggregate index include the industry data aggregated into the Selected Health Care index, the Information sector index and the Other Selected Services indexes.
