INMATE ESCAPES FROM POLLOCK PENITENTIARY

On April 5, 2006, inmate Richard McNair, age 47, was discovered missing from the United States Penitentiary in Pollock, Louisiana. Inmate McNair is a white male with blue eyes and brown hair. He is 6 feet tall and weighs approximately 210 pounds. He has scars on his left wrist and both knees.

Inmate McNair is a North Dakota Department of Corrections inmate being housed by the Bureau of Prisons. He is serving a life sentence for Murder, Criminal Attempt, and Burglary. He is a native of Minot, North Dakota.

The FBI, U.S. Marshals Service and local law enforcement have been notified and escape procedures are in effect.
