DESTINATION CONTROL STATEMENT

Used to prevent items licensed for export from being diverted while in transit or thereafter, it should be on:

- □ Invoice
- Airway Bill
- Bill of Lading
- All export control documents that accompany the shipment

It is required for all export of items on the Commerce Control List, except for EAR 99 items or items exported under license exceptions GFT or BAG.

"These commodities, technology or software were exported from the United States in Accordance with the Export Administration Regulations. Diversion contrary to US law is prohibited."

ENERGY TRADE LEADS

CAMEROON: USTDA AWARDS OVER \$1.3 MILLION IN GRANTS FOR POWER SECTOR

Expanding the power generation capacity in Cameroon to alleviate severe power shortages and to support economic growth are the goals of two USTDA grants, totaling more than \$1.3 million, awarded May 16 to the Cameroonian Ministry of Energy and Water Resources. The first grant will fund technical assistance on the conversion from heavy fuel oil to natural gas and expansion of the Limbé Power Plant. The second grant will be used to conduct investment analysis on the construction of a proposed hydropower plant in the Northern Province, at Warak.
